

TEACHER Q CHART – FORMING QUESTIONS

Aim for the higher level questions three and four. e.g., WHY WOULD the character make that decision? This is a level 3 question asking for higher-level thinking.

1. Select a word from the left hand column of the Q-chart
2. Select a word from the upper row of the Q-chart

The axis provides the question starting words
