ADA 10: Objects of Character Scenario Descriptions

Objects: Flowers and Rosary

Scenario: Twelve year old Joan of Arc is picking flowers in the fields near her home in Domremy, France when she first hears the voices of Saint Catherine, Saint Margaret and Archangel Michael. She is afraid, yet when the voices disappear, she cries because they are so beautiful.

Objects: Letters in French, writing pen

Scenario: Joan writes a series of three letters to the Lord Dauphin Charles to inform him of the mission she has received from her voices. She pleads for a military escort to the Royal Court in Chinon to meet with him and ask him to allow her to lead the French army to battle.

Objects: Scissors, Women's Clothing

Scenario: The voices instruct Joan of her mission to defeat the English. She receives word that she will be allowed to travel to the Royal Court to tell the Lord Dauphin of her mission. It is a long journey, and to protect herself she must disguise herself as a man.

Objects: Banner, Battle Armour

Scenario: Joan meets with the Lord Dauphin and convinces him to allow her to meet the French army. She prepares herself for battle.
